Subject:- Recognition of the Courses offered by the Jamia Urdu Aligarh for the purposes of recruitment under the Central Government

The undersigned is directed to say that on the recommendations of the Board of Assessment for Educational Qualifications, the Government of India have decided to recognise the following courses offered by the Jamia Urdu, Aligarh for the purposes of employment under the Central Government:

<u>Name of the Certificate</u>	<u>Nature of Recognition</u>
Adeeb Examination /Standard	Recognised for the purposes of employment to the posts which require knowledge of Urdu of High School/Matriculation.
Adeeb-e-Mahir	Recognised for the purposes of employment to the posts which require knowledge of Urdu of Intermediate standard.
Adeeb-e-Kamil	Recognised for the purposes of employment to the posts which require knowledge of Urdu of B.A. standard.
Moslim-e-Urdū	Recognised for the purposes of employment to the posts which require a qualification for teaching Urdu language up to Higher Secondary Standard.
